### **GUIDELINES**

#### **All Project Proposals/Applications Must:**

-  be implemented within the school environment during the 2011-2012 school year
-  clearly state the details of the proposal including how you would spend the money, the type of volunteer jobs our members could assist with (if applicable), and specific information on how your students would be positively affected
-  include all applicable contact information

#### **Publication and Distribution**

JLGWH may publish, distribute, and make available to the public the names of Grantees and the results and/or outcomes of the proposed project. Generally, the publication shall be in newspapers, on the JLGWH website ([www.jlgwh.org](http://www.jlgwh.org)) and/or in similar media.
